

New Fall Season Update Outdoor 2024

This year traditional Fall Programs will look different across Calgary Minor Soccer as the Fall Season will no longer feature continued league play at all levels. Replacing the traditional CMSA fall league extension will be a CMSA Tournament or “Fall Series” Sept 13-15 providing an opt-in competitive option for teams dependent on the level for U10-U17. This event will be strongly encouraged for all T1-2 and Development Plus + teams as part of your Outdoor registration program. This shift in philosophy helps overcome the obstacles that often challenge the fall season viability such as multisport players transitioning to winter sports, AYSL September intake for 2011 players, girls high school soccer and Junior High soccer opportunities for players.

This will likely result in clubs transitioning to the indoor season earlier with the potential of advancement of the indoor season kicking off a little earlier in October. MUSC will continue to provide our traditional academy, training and exhibition games through the fall (as part of the Development + and Tier 1-2 level) with an increase in friendly matches to maintain a periodized transition into the indoor season.

Development and T3-5 players will additionally be provided with developmental opportunities through the fall ensuring all interested players are given the opportunity to stay on the ball, however due to the fact that Fall interest tends to vary at these levels of play this program option will be OPTIONAL at a minimum cost for these levels. Participation in the Fall Series tournament is also available to Tier 3-5 and development teams but requires the full team or majority of the team being interested and invested.
